

PINE KNOLL SHORES POLICE DEPARTMENT Reentry Pass Reminder

Effective immediately, Pine Knoll Shores reentry passes will be issued from December 1 through May 31 only. No passes will be issued during hurricane season. Pine Knoll Shores residents and homeowners are encouraged to check your reentry passes now to be sure you know where they are. If you are unable to find your pass, stop by the public safety building at 314 Salter Path Road before May 31 and pick up a new one. Please be prepared to show your driver's license with your Pine Knoll Shores address, a utility bill with your address or your purchase/ rental paperwork. We cannot issue a reentry pass without one of these types of documentation. If you are out of town and will not return before May 31, please email Natalie Gibble at ngibble@townofpks.com to make arrangements for your pass. Please note that there is a \$25 fee for replacing a previously issued pass.
