The number one complaint received by PKA has to do with boats causing a wake by traveling at excessive speed along the canal. Earlier signage indicated a speed of 5 miles per hour was adequate for no wake; however, upon further examination, many boats leave a significant wake at that speed. Therefore, you are requested to travel the canal at idle speed only.

A few work days are needed to make repairs to the sittum at Ocean Park and the center dock at Hall Haven. Please check the PKA website and Facebook page for a work schedule and volunteer accordingly. Any help you can give will be greatly appreciated.
