

Adam and Michele Phillips' bucket-list adventure began in March in Georgia as they hit the Appalachian Trail, with plans to hike all 2,180+ miles of it. The trail goes through 14 states and two national parks, and takes the average hiker six months to complete. Adam and Michele hope to end up in Maine in September.

Conceived in 1921, built by private citizens and completed in 1937, today the trail is managed by the National Park Service, US Forest Service, Appalachian Trail Conservancy, numerous state agencies and thousands of volunteers.

The Phillipses have been selected by Warrior Expeditions (WE), a non-profit veteran support organization, to be a part of the 2022 AT (Appalachian Trail)
