rently have at the aquarium, it does not happen in snakes. Instead, the mothers simply keep watch and presumably protect the vulnerable babies from predators, especially black racers and kingsnakes. Their best efforts, however, are not always successful, and only about one in three young snakes is estimated to survive into adulthood—but that is a story for another day.
