TOWN APPROVES CAMA

UPDATING CONTRACT

The Board of Commissioners, meeting on Tuesday, November 11, approved a contract between the town and the North Carolina Department of Natural Resources and Community Development that will provide planning services for updating the CAMA Land Use Plan. The contract was presented to the Board by Commissioner Larry Jerome.

At the same time the Board approved a proposed subcontract for a planning consultant to be named Planner of the Update of the Land Use Plan. Under the terms of the contract the town will pay its local share of the planning costs.

Commissioner Jerome also presented to the Board a recommendation from the Planning Board, along with a suggested ordinance, with respect to clearing out dead and diseased trees. The Planning Board suggested that the ordinance would be useful to protect the public health and safety, to protect public and private property from damage, reduce the possibility of interruption of public utility services and to protect the environment and the maritime forest from deterioration. Under the ordinance the town, working with a competent tree expert, will determine if a tree creates a hazard and should be removed, and if so, will notify the owner. The ordinance was approved by the Board.

With respect to other business at the Board meeting, Commissioner El Ratliffe, of Streets and Public Property, presented a municipal agreement for the inspection and inventory of the Mimosa and Oak-leaf bridges between the town and the North Carolina Department of Transportation. The Board accepted the resolution to use the services of the Department of Transportation or a consulting engineering firm retained by Department of Transportation to inventory and inspect the town's bridges in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards.

In his report, Commissioner Jack Thompson announced with regret that Police Officer Charles Adams has resigned to enter private
