At the Commissioners' meeting August 13th Commissioner Thompson read the letter sent to Police Chief Edgar William Crawford from the Attorney General and Director David D. Cashwell, Director of the Criminal Justice Standards Division of the Department of Justice, announcing his selection as a recipient of that department's highest award, the Law Enforcement Officers' Advanced Certificate. To be considered for this award the candidate must have spent at least nine years in law enforcement and have earned a minimum of 90 points in college and training credits. Selection is then based on individual performance. In his letter Director Cashwell said: "Your dedication to your chosen profession will be evidenced in the fact that you will be one of a very select group of officers receiving this honor..."
