THE SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATION

Notification of a Search and Rescue emergency will normally be received via established police communication system.

Such information requesting Civil Preparedness assistance by the Police Department will be reported to the Civil Preparedness director. He will assume full charge for the conduct of the Search and Rescue operation. This operation shall be conducted in accordance with the Civil Preparedness Plan -- example:

- 1. Establish and operate an Emergency Center [EOC].
- 2. Establish and operate a communiciations center.
- 3. Coordinate man power resources; police, fire, rescue, civil preparedness.
- 4. Establish search and rescue area in accordance with reported incident.

Search and Rescue notification will be issued through the area coordinator and Block Captains. This notification will include the name and description of the individual and reason for the search.

Please be advised whenever a Search and Rescue operation is requested, the Town Police will be informed first.
