We asked Gayle Piner if this was unusual. She said it was unusual for Pine Knoll Shores but as yet there are not appreciably more this year than other years in the whole area. Most of them had obviously been dead for a long time before they washed up on our beach. No local phenomena is being held responsible for their demise.

LIBRARY DAY BIG SUCCESS

Library Day on June 24th was a big success. Visitors at the Open House were served cookies and punch. Over 200 visitors came and many made contributions. Several stores on Bogue Banks were also stations for collection of donations. The total take that day alone was over \$2000.
