
HI THERE!

IT'S NEW AND GREAT!



Pine Knoll Shores Commissioners on June 9, approved the town's 1992-93 budget which includes a \$.02 cent increase in the property tax rate, from \$.15 cents to \$.17 cents per \$100 of assessed property value. The increase will cost the owner of a \$100,000 house about \$20.00 more in taxes. \$70,000 from the uncommitted fund was used to balance the budget in order to keep taxes down.
