Library costs are based on population. The four Bogue Banks towns are asked to pay the following amounts: Atlantic Beach \$11,000; Emerald Isle, \$10,000; Indian Beach, \$1,000; and Pine Knoll Shores, \$13,700. The Pine Knoll Shores Commissioners budgeted \$13,700 for the library in the 1992-93 fiscal year. That budget was approved this week.

Land Use Update Plan:

Consideration of the submission of the Land Use Plan Update to Department of Coastal Management for comment and review is the next step toward the adoption of the plan. Citizen Clyde Lynn asked that the policy statement concerning a third bridge, be changed to plainly state that Pine Knoll Shores opposes a third bridge. He questioned the usefulness of the mandated land use plans. Commissioner Musgrave moved that the policy statement read "The Town of Pine Knoll Shores is opposed to the location of a third bridge." Seconded by Commissioner Gallo. The vote was unanimous.

PikSCO Agreement

He moved that an agreement between the Town and PikSCO be approved to allow this action and, further, that Mayor Kanyha be authorized to sign this agreement. This was seconded by Commissioner Hasulak.
