


**R U New to Pine Knoll Shores?**

### FROM THE BUILDING INSPECTOR

With cold weather creeping in on us, many people are beginning to use their heating systems. Whether you utilize fireplaces, gas, electric, or any other form of heating equipment, care should be taken before putting the equipment back to use. A simple examination of the equipment before use may prevent the likelihood of fire, electrical shock, or other accidents from happening.

Fireplaces should be thoroughly cleaned, free of soot and creosote buildup. Dampers should be functioning properly also. Be sure leaves, and tree limbs have adequate clearances from the chimney cap. Residents with fireplaces should consult with a professional "Chimney Sweep" for a complete inspection and cleaning.
