October Board of Commissioners Meeting

Public Hearing

There will be a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 14, 2000 at 2:00 p.m. prior to the regular Town Board meeting to receive public input on the establishment of Service Districts for the purpose of financing, providing, and maintaining a municipal service district for beach erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works by a system of Atlantic Ocean beach renourishment.

The tax revenues derived from the proposed service district will be used to finance a comprehensive beach renourishment project within the Town of Pine Knoll Shores.

October 10 - Public Hearing

There were no public comments on Tuesday, October 10 at the Public Hearing prior to the regular Town Board meeting concerning amending subsection 2-4.3 of the Pine Knoll Shores Municipal Code.

The purpose of the amendment is the creation of protocol of the Planning Board and its procedures. It is critical for the Planning Board to have a procedure that ensures a thorough review of all development plans and matters that affect land use in Pine Knoll Shores.
