If a permanent re-entry permit was previously issued a replacement will cost \$20. Re-entry permits can be obtained at Town Hall, but don't wait until the last minute. No permits will be issued once the evacuation order is given. Proof of residence is required.\*\*

\*\*\*PLEASE BE ADVISED\*\*\*Waste Industries will collect large bulk items on Friday, October 25, 2002 such as: (furniture, mattresses, large appliances, small appliances, empty lawn mowers, construction and demolition material 4' or less and not over 50 lbs. and other small loose items placed in a box, bag, or bundle) Large appliances will be picked up by a separate truck the same day.
