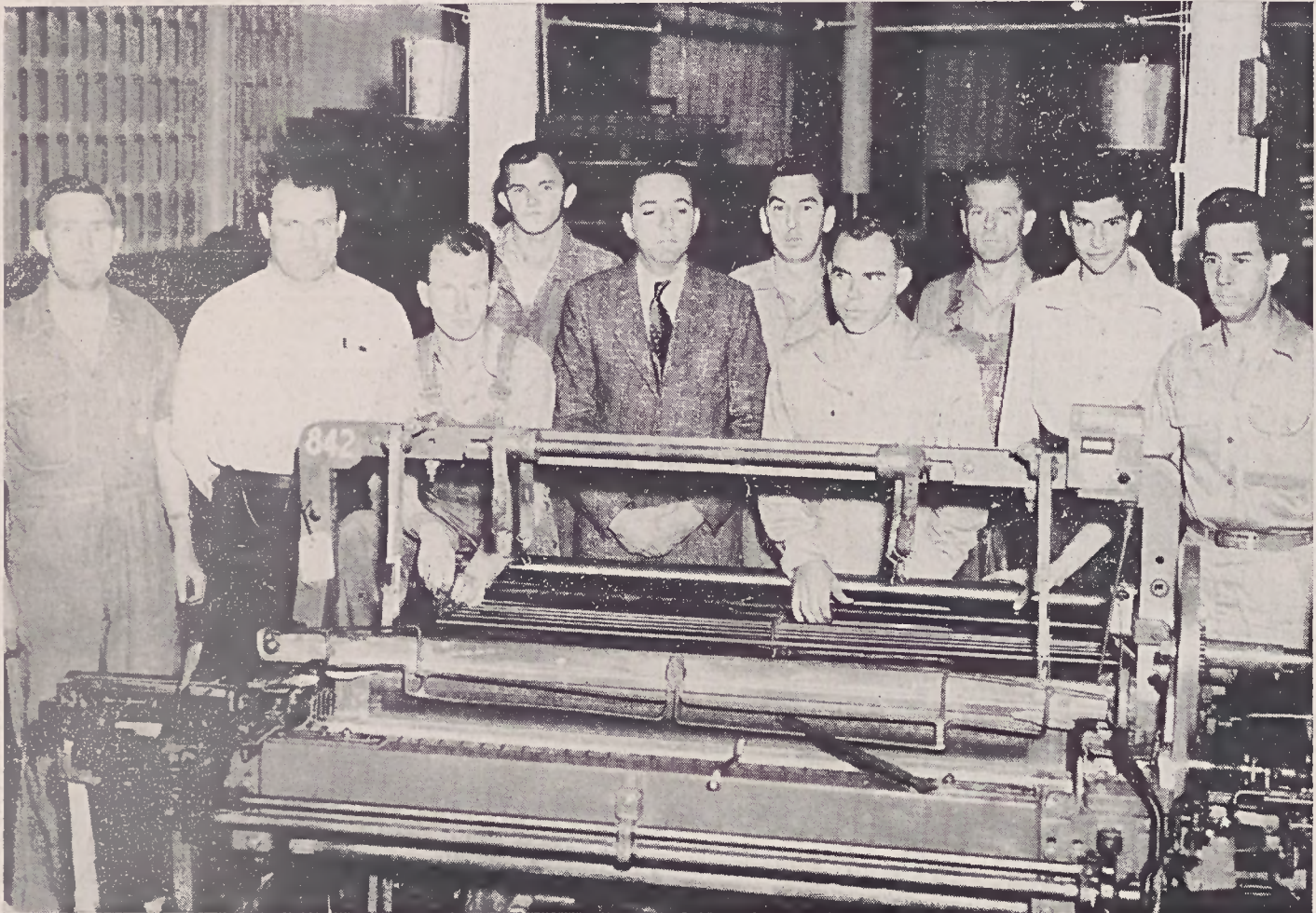


Sheeting Mill Men Take Part In Loom Fixer Selection And Training Course
