Two Weeks' Vacation Is Set For Period June 30 To July 14

Official notices have been posted announcing that all mills in the North Carolina and Virginia area will stand for two weeks' vacation beginning Monday, June 30 and extending through Sunday, July 13. All mills will resume operations on regular schedule Monday, July 14.

Vacation pay will be issued on the regular pay days during the week beginning June 23.

Pay for work performed during the week ending June 29 will be available for employees at each Mill Cashier's office according to the following schedule: from 10 a. m. to 12 noon, Wednesday, July 2, Bleachery, Central Warehouse, Specials, Embroidered Bedspread, Woolen, Finishing, and Rayon; from 10 a. m. to 12 noon, Thursday, July 3, Towel, Hosiery, Bedspread, Blanket Sheeting and Karastan.

Cafeteria Will Close During Mills' Vacation

Sunday Service To Begin July 20; Slight Change To Be Made In Hours

In view of the mills' vacation period, Edward Mallieoat, manager, Y. M. C. A. Fieldcrest Cafeteria, has announced that the cafeteria will close after the evening meal Friday, June 27, and will reopen with the noon meal Monday, July 14.

The manager pointed out that effective July 14 there will be slight changes in the serving hours. Beginning July 14 the noon meal will be served from 11:30 a. m. until 1:30 p. m. instead of from 11:15 a. m. until 1:15 p. m. as was done heretofore. The evening meal will be served from 5 p. m. until 7 p. m. instead of from 5:30 p. m. until 7:30 p. m. as was done previously.

The cafeteria will serve Sunday meals starting July 20 and will be open from 12 noon until 2 p. m. and from 5 p. m. until 7 p. m. All employees and the general public are invited to take ad-
