

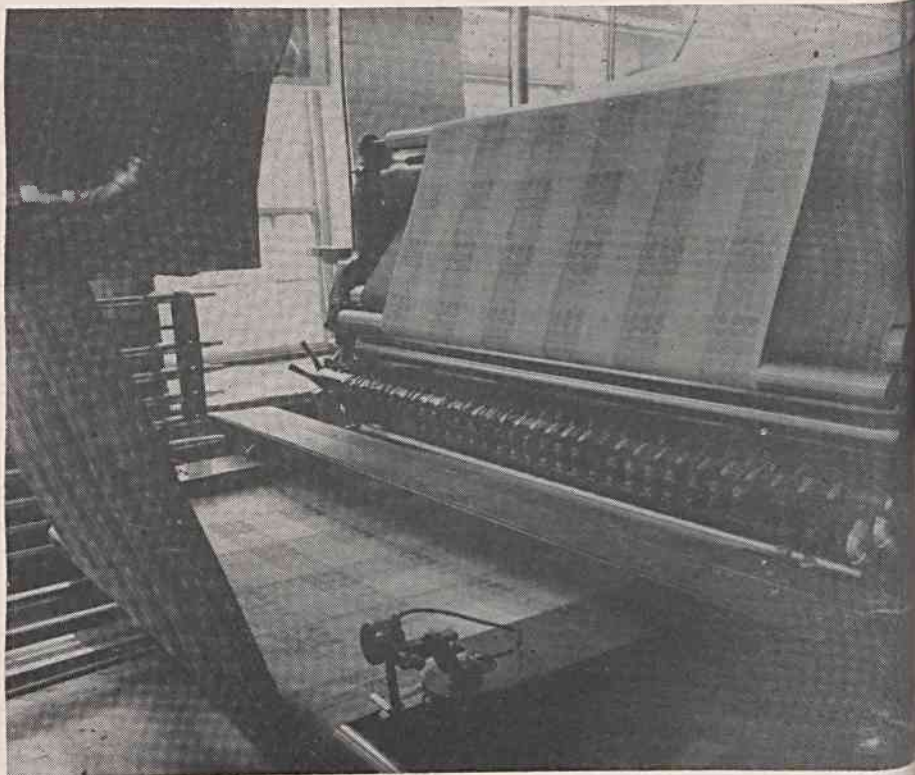
## New Members

**CLIP EXPANDER** (tenter-like device in foreground) is shown in this close view. The clip expander holds the goods to the proper width during the Sanforizing process. Row of "shoes" shown at right, press the goods to the Sanforizing blanket. The metal shoes are electrically heated and each unit has its own thermostat. The shoes are very important in getting uniform shrinkage and have to be watched closely.

Complex and delicate controls are used with the machine which employs two kinds of electric current: two of alternating and one of direct current.

A wash test room near the machine is headquarters for tests which are made to determine the amount of shrinkage in the goods before Sanforizing and after the process to make sure that shrinkage is within tolerance. The Sanforizer label guarantees against shrinkage of more than one per cent.
