Following his graduation from M.I.T., he was associated with the General Electric Company in various parts of the country in engineering and quality control assignments. He served with an ordnance unit in the U. S. Army from May, 1955, until December, 1956.

Mr. Delahooke is a native of Pennsylvania, and joined Fieldcrest as a development engineer at the Automatic Blanket Mill in July, 1958. He was appointed quality control engineer in December, 1959, and continued in that capacity until his most recent promotion. He attended Virginia Military Institute and the University of Maine before going to Iowa State College where he received his B. S. degree in electrical engineering in 1949.

Upon graduation he joined the General Electric Company in their engineering training program and completed the creative engineering program. He served in various engineering capacities for General Electric at several locations. In 1952 he was assigned to that company's automatic blanket plant at Ashboro in manufacturing planning and remained there until August 1956. He then was associated with the Southern Tool Manufacturing Company at Winston-Salem in engineering, supervision, and sales capacities, until he joined Fieldcrest Mills in July, 1958.
