## Your Social Security: Questions And Answers

**Q. I am 35 years old, married and have four small children. Eleven months ago I was in an automobile accident and I haven't worked since. Am I eligible for anything from social security? How about my wife and children?**

**A. The 1960 amendments permit monthly payments to disabled workers under age 50, their wives regardless of age (as long as they have at least one minor child in their care) and all unmarried minor children. You should inquire immediately at your nearest social security office about these payments.**

**Q. I had to stop work because of a severe heart condition about a year ago. I'll be 50 years old in three months. How soon should I apply for my benefits?**

**A. You should apply immediately. Because of the 1960 amendments an insured disabled worker may receive monthly benefits even though he is less than 50 years old.**
