After seeing the displays in the showroom and visiting the Designing De-

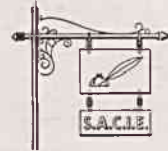
partment they were conducted on a tour of the plant to see steps in the manufacture of Karastan rugs and carpets.
