

# Bedspread Weave Has Outstanding Safety Record

Employees of the Bedspread Mill Weave Room have achieved a record of more than one million man-hours of work without a lost time injury. Through January 20, 1963, members of the department had worked a total of 1,021,907 man-hours since the last disabling injury occurred July 13, 1959.
