

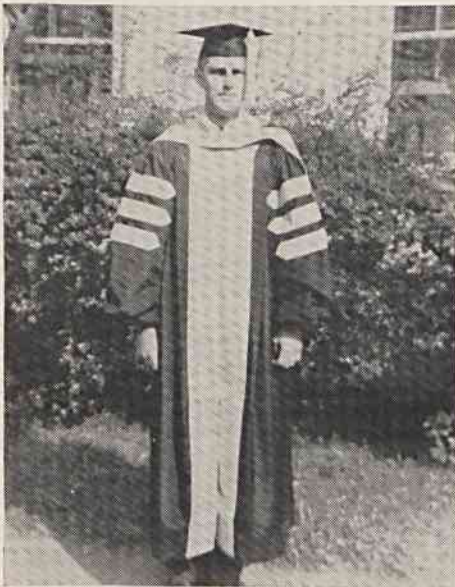
Sharon Robbins Is 'Miss Fieldale High'

Sharon, 15, was in the ninth grade during the last school year and was president of her class and president of the school Spanish Club.

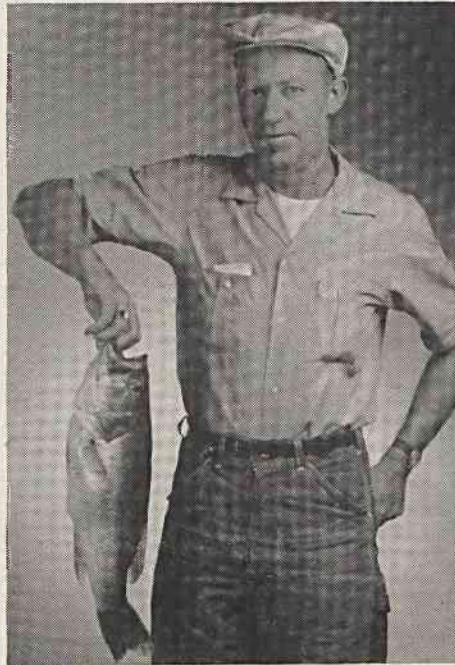
Gets D.V.M. Degree
