For the convenience of employees, the Fieldcrest Store at Spray is observing the following Christmas shopping hours:

The store will be closed for the holidays Wednesday and Thursday, December 25 and 26, and will resume its regular hours Friday, December 27.

The employee Christmas charge plan at the store continues to be popular, with many Fieldcresters taking advantage of the convenient arrangement when they do their Christmas shopping.

Under the plan, on purchases between now and December 24, employees at all locations may charge up to \$50 worth of merchandise and pay for it by payroll deductions after January 1.

Ten weekly deductions will be made on the weekly payroll and two deductions (from the January and February checks) will be made on the monthly payroll.

Employees using the plan must personally sign the payroll authorization card.

Also, the 1963 Fieldcrest Store employee identification card must be presented at the time of the sale.
