They were Henry Childress, foreman of the Dressing Department, and Ray Moss, assistant foreman in the Carding and Spinning Department.

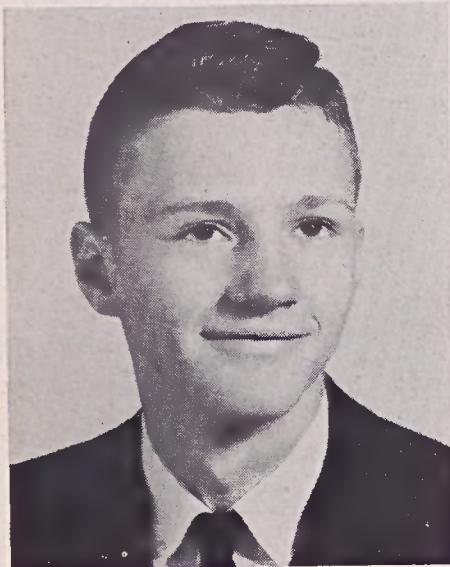
