

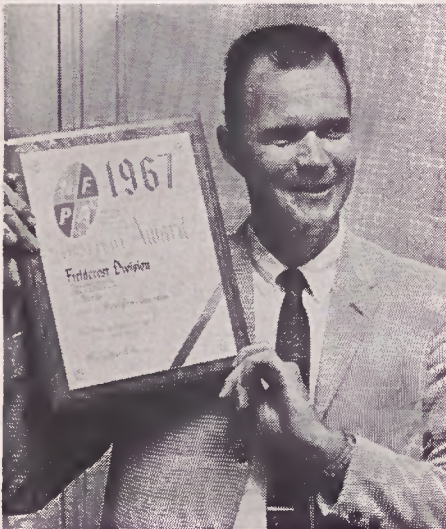

Textile Industry Pays \$711 Million In Taxes

The textile industry paid an estimated \$711,178,020 in taxes during 1966, according to a survey made by the American Textile Manufacturers Institute.

The ATMI said that, of the total, \$571,040,000 was paid in federal taxes, \$84,448,540 in state taxes and \$55,689,480 in local taxes.
