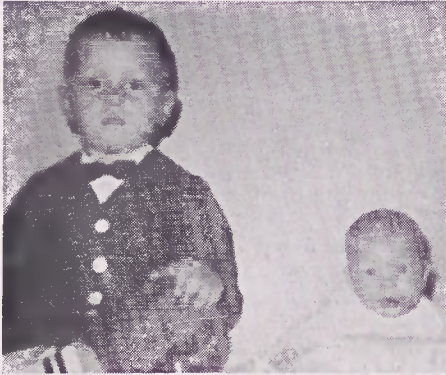


# - News About Children -
