Elected Trustee

D. A. Purcell, general manager of towel manufacturing and manager of the Fieldcrest Towel Mill, has been elected a trustee of Ferrum Junior College, at Ferrum, Va. He is among the nine new trustees to be installed in October for a seven-year term.

Mr. Purcell has been associated with Fieldcrest for 30 years and is an active leader in industry and civic affairs. He is a native of Rockingham County and graduated from Greensboro High School. He received his B. S. degree in textile manufacturing at North Carolina State College, where he graduated with honors and was named to Phi Kappa Phi, a national honorary society. He was associated with textile companies in various southern states prior to joining Fieldcrest in 1938.

He was superintendent of the Fieldcrest Blanket and Sheeting Mills, at

Draper, and later was given responsibility for finishing, warehousing and shipping operations. He has been manager of the Fieldcrest Towel Mill since 1955. In 1966, he was given the additional responsibility for the Muscogee Mill, Columbus, Ga.; the Mount Holly Spinning Mill, Mount Holly; and the Worthville Spinning Mill, Worthville.
