Mr. Chowning has been with Fieldcrest since April, 1966, and first worked as a management trainee at the Blanket

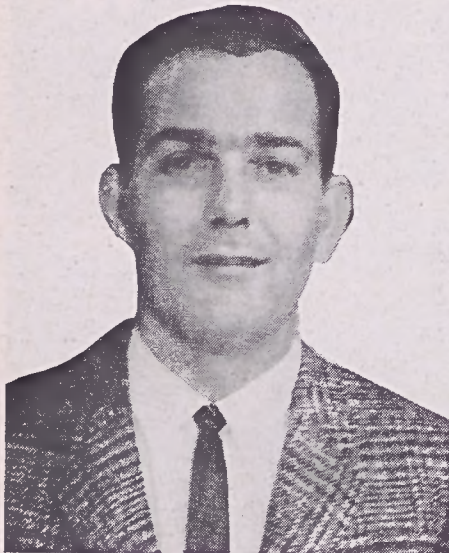
