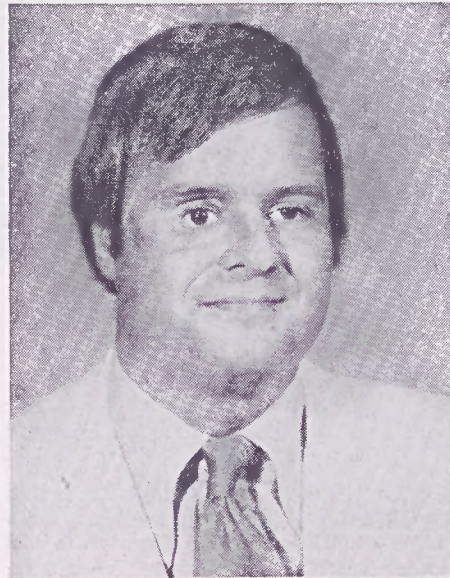

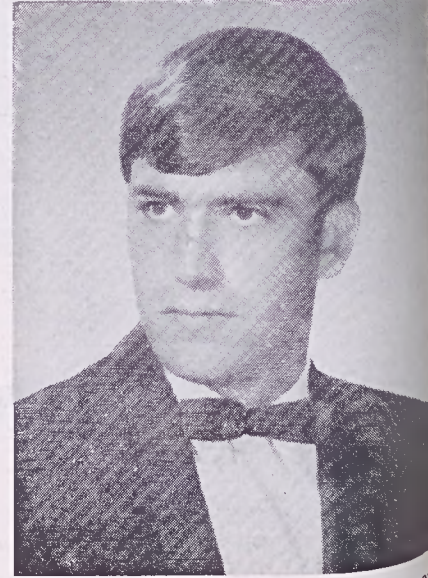

## Credit Union Members Will Receive 6% Dividend

Members of the Fieldcrest Mills Credit Union in all locations will receive a 6% per annum dividend, figured on their average monthly balances and credited to each member's share account as of June 30, 1971.

The dividend was authorized by the Credit Union's board of directors at

their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, June 10.

The interest rate on Credit Union savings accounts was increased to 6% effective July 1, 1970. It previously was 5½% and has never been less than 4% since the organization of the Credit Union 13 years ago.
