

Washing Department Has Fine Record

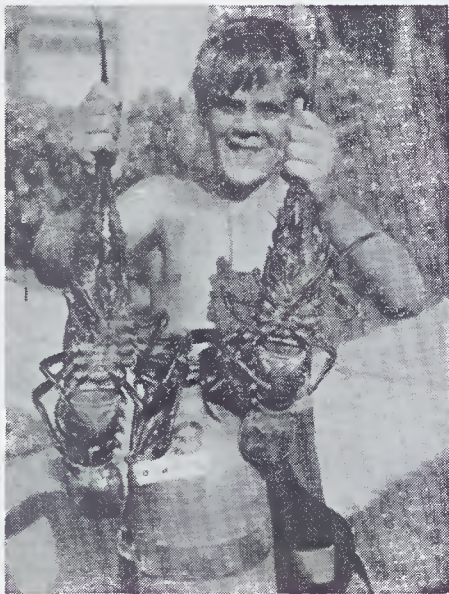
