Gardner Speaks At National Safety Council

James E. Gardner, training manager for Fieldcrest Mills, Inc., was one of the speakers at the 1971 National Safety Congress and Exposition in Chicago October 25-28. He spoke on the program of the Textile Section on Tuesday afternoon, October 26, at the Conrad Hilton Hotel.

His topic was "Motivation of Employees with Particular Reference to Safety." He pointed out that safety behavior, like any other behavior, can be explained in terms of the motivation

"Although safety is not usually a need that in itself motivates employees, it

can be used as a means by which other more important and compelling needs can be met," he said.
