

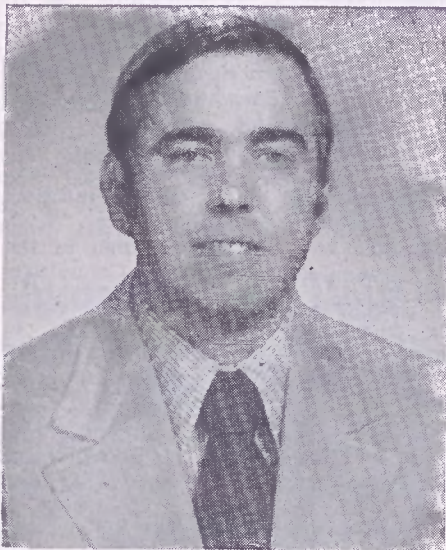


## 11 Attain Perfect Attendance Records In '72

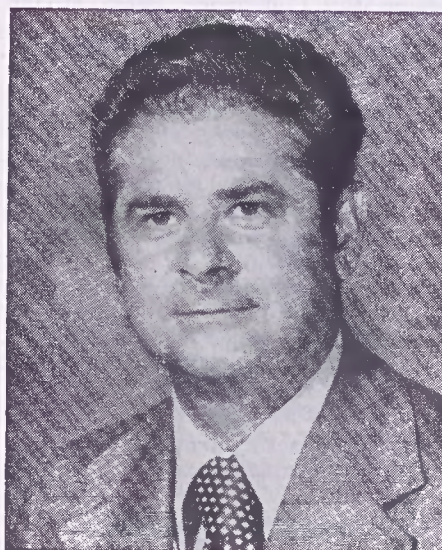
Eleven employees at the Bedsread Finishing Mill achieved perfect attendance for the year 1972.
