Corry Named Stokesdale Personnel Manager

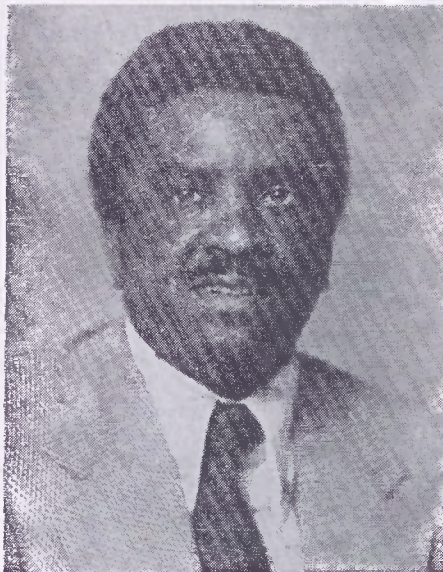
Jesse D. Corry, Jr., joined Fieldcrest Mills on March 1 as area personnel manager at Foremost Screen Print Plant, Stokesdale.
