Also distributed to visitors were copies of a special commemorative edition of The Mill Whistle which was published in connection with the company's 20th anniversary.

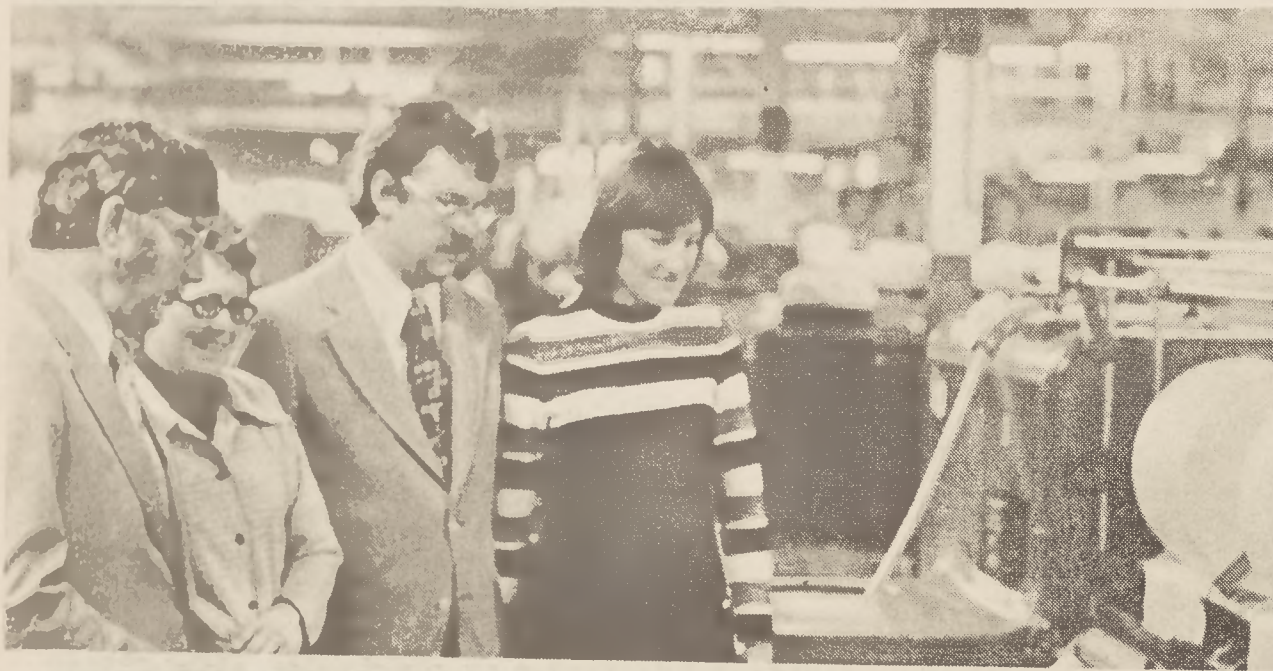
Members of the 25-Year Club — employees with continuous service ranging from 25 to over 50 years — were given special recognition during the "open house".
