

Honored For Long Service

Six Fieldcrest employees were honored recently for completing 40 years of continuous service with the company.

They are: Howard C. Honeycutt, loom fixer, Alexander Sheeting Mill; Edward L. Joyce, department foreman, Bedsread Mill; Alice C. Johnson, weaver, Alexander Sheeting Mill; Robert M. Smoot, general foreman, North Carolina Finishing; Claude H. Snider, line up utility operator, North Carolina Finishing Company; and Andrew W. Warren, shift foreman, Fielddale Towel Mill.

Each long-service employee has received the Fieldcrest 40-year service emblem, a \$40 gift certificate for company merchandise, and a letter of commendation from William C. Battle, president of Fieldcrest Mills, Inc.

Mr. Honeycutt began continuous service on December 23, 1935, as a battery filler at the Alexander Sheeting Mill. He became a loom fixer, his present classification, in 1965.
