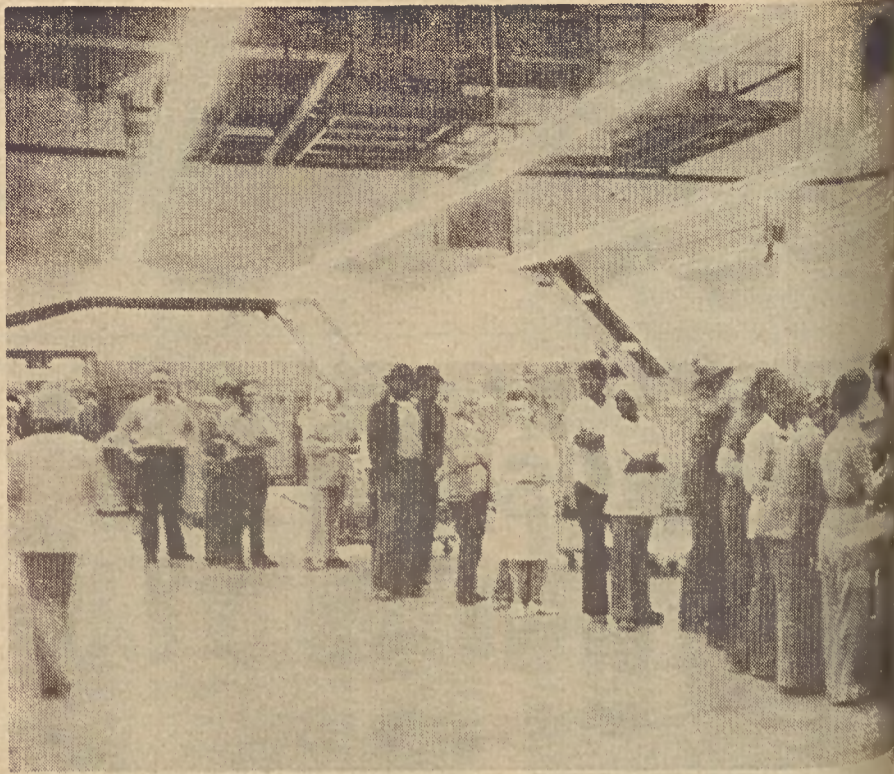

lost time injury.

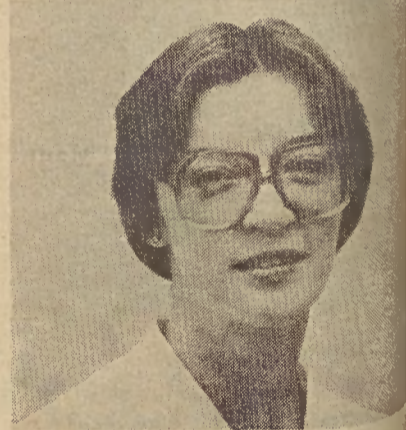
The Phenix City employees have achieved a total of 1,549,614 safe work hours.
