

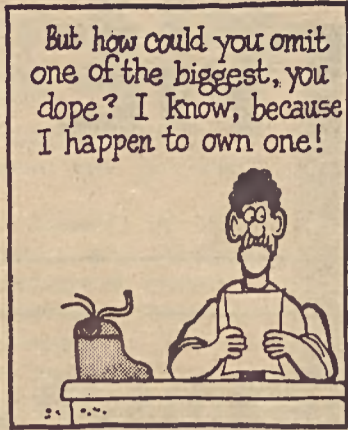
## Karastan Featured In Comic Strip

## Three Join Fieldcrest

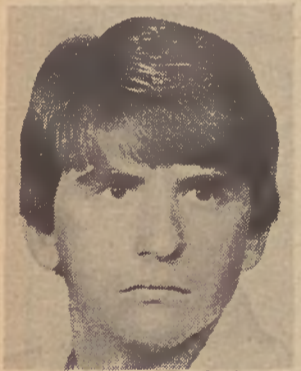
Three new employees recently joined Fieldcrest Mills, Inc.
