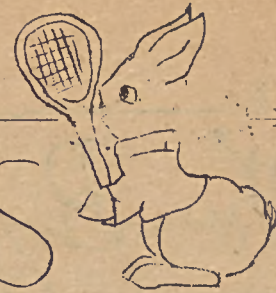


S P O R T S
