Society is a group of people interested in the writings of C.S. Lewis. Lewis, perhaps the foremost Christian apologist of the twentieth century, was a professor of medieval literature and laguage at both Oxford and Cambridge. He became a Christian in his late twenties and turned from his rather adamant atheistic early manhood to become a strong defender of the Christian faith and world view.

For example, in Mere Christianity he says that each individual must honestly put Him off by saying that He was only a great moral teacher and not the Son of God: "A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic-- in a level with the man who says he is a poached eda-- or else he would be the Devil of


