Jeff Bryson presented the budget from Student Activities and it was passed with the understanding that as changes occur, SGA will approve them. Nate Tiefenbach moved and Sarah Ennis seconded that motion. The Student Budget Advisory Committee will begin meeting soon. Those members are Jeff Bryson, Woody Quinn, Renee Pittman, Sarah Hicks, and Donovan Campbell (as the Whetstone Representative).

The meeting was adjourned at 9:55 p.m


