Brittany



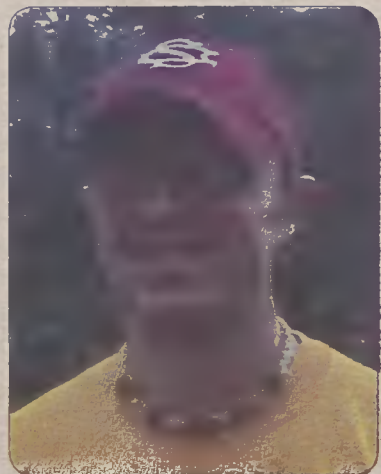
