1. Ask your doctor about receiving pollen "desensitiza-tion" treatment. It may relieve symptoms when pollen starts flying. 2. Ask your doctor if he

thinks drugs, such as anti-histamines, might help relieve your symptoms.

3. Stay indoors with air conditioning. This helps isolate you from pollen in the air outside.

4. Take a vacation where ragweed is scarce or nonexistent.


