AREA RUGS

An area rug can give your room an exciting touch by imbuing it with color, texture and pattern at a reasonable cost.

An area rug should be selected to serve as a focal point in a room. For a living room or den, place in the center of it your seating arrangement to unify the furniture. The pieces should sit entirely on the rug or off it; don't place the back legs of the sofa on the floor and the front legs on the rug unless you want it to rock

rug. You may want a small 4 x 6 foot rug to sit in front of your sofa or you might like a large 12 x 15 foot one which will cover most of the floor. Consider these things before making a decision: 1. What's the condition of the floor? If the wood has a shiny, rich cared-for look, why cover all of it? If you have beat-up floors which are beyond repair, look for a large area rug. 2. If your room is very large, a 4 x 6 would look ridiculous. Keep things in scale. 3. Use area rugs to define space. If you have an L-shaped living and dining room, a large square rug for the living room and a rectangular one under the dining and chairs will make the area look more like two. The best thing about area rugs is the vitality and unity they can add to any room or hall.

Rice And Lamb Casserole

Now that fall is nearly here, this easy to prepare dish will make a welcome appearance on the dinner table. To serve 6 you'll need: 3 cups finely chopped cooked lamb 2¹/₂ cups cooked rice 2½ cups cooked lice 3 tbs. minced onion Pinch of cayenne pepper 1 cup chicken broth* 3 tbs. lemon juice Salt and pepper to taste 3 tbs. melted butter 1/ cup frach cracker ¹/₂ cup fresh cracker crumbs

Preheat oven to 350 de-grees F. Combine lamb, rice, onion, cayenne, broth and lemon juice in large bowl. Mix well. Add salt and pepper. Place in a greased $1\frac{1}{2}$ quart baking dish. Toss the melted butter and crumbs together and sprinkle over the top. Cover with a piece of buttered wax paper and bake for 20 minutes. Remove paper and bake 15 minutes longer, or until crumbs are lightly browned. If you prefer potatoes to rice, use tiny new ones and bake them with the lamb. Serve with hot Irish Soda Bread and a crisp mixed green salad to put a sharp edge on fall ap-

petites. *Lamb gravy may be substituted for the chicken broth.
