Vanity has long played a role in preventing the hearing impaired from seeking assistance. This new device requires no visible aids or amplifiers. Completely selfcontained, it is concealed in the frames of a fashionable pair of glasses, suitable for every age bracket.


Also new from the same company is a device for taking blood pressure that can be used at home. The unit gives digital readings and "stores" information for later comparison.



The Tax-Exempt All-Savers Certificate is a one-year certificate, issued between October 1, 1981 and December 31, 1982 with a yield equal to 70% of the average yield on 52-week Treasury Bills.

Can I use this certificate as collateral or security for a

If you do, then the interest on the certificate loses its taxexempt status and you will have to pay tax on the interest earned.

If I have to cash in my certificate prior to maturity, can I do so?

Yes, you can. However, you will lose the tax-exempt status on the interest on the certificate and all the interest. earned will be subject to income tax.

A substantial penalty is required by law in the event of early withdrawal of funds from a certificate.




