Muir, a Scotsman who died in 1959, describes the "seven days war that put the world to sleep":

Dead bodies piled on the deck. On the sixth day
A plane plunged over us into the sea. Thereafter
Nothing.*

And then Muir describes, the survivors hear the horses:

*We had sold our horses in our fathers' time
To buy new tractors. . . Yet they waited,
Stubborn and shy, as if they had been sent
By an old command. . .*

*Since then they have pulled our plows and borne
our loads,
Our life is changed; their coming our beginning.*
