

# Our Best Recipes

**CINNAMON BUNS** 

- 1 c. warm milk (120°)
- l pkg. dry yeast
- 2 Tbsp. sugar
- 2 Tbsp. shortening
- 3 c. flour
- l tsp. salt

Dissolve yeast in warm milk. Add sugar, shortening, salt and half of flour. Beat well. Stir in remainder of flour. Let rise 1 hour in a warm place or until double in bulk. Punch down dough and roll out on pastry cloth to ½ inch thick. Spread lightly with softened butter and sprinkle with brown sugar and cinnamon. Roll up as for jelly roll and slice. Place on greased pan, cover, and let rise until doubled in bulk -about 2 hours. Bake at 400° until lightly browned. If desired, frost with powdered sugar icing. Makes 12 large buns.

### MY ANSWER BY DR. BILLY GRAHAM



Dear Dr. Graham: Every so often I read something in the newspaper by someone who says they think the world may end soon through something like a nuclear war. Does the Bible teach that the world will end in this way?

Dear A.L.: The Bible does not specifically say how the world will end, and we must be cautious about making definite predictions. 2 Peter 3:10, however, states: "But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be bare."

Does this describe the aftermath of a nuclear war? Some readers of the Bible feel it does, and certainly the terrible weapons we have developed could have this effect. My own view, however, is that it is God, not man, who will bring to an end the present world age. If a nuclear war ever happens it will be because some human pushed the button. Although nuclear war would be a horrible thing, I do not believe God would allow the human race to destroy itself completely. The final curtain on this world as we know it will be drawn by God, not man. That is one reason we should not be complacent about the threat of nuclear war or assume that somehow it would be God's means of final judgment on the earth. Christians have a responsibility to work for peace, because it is God's will "That we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness" (I Timothy 2:2).

There are two other things I would like to stress, however. One is the wonderful fact that God's purpose is not just to destroy the evil in this world, but to re-create the worlds afresh. "But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness" (2 Peter 3:13). Some day evil will be destroyed, and Christ will reign forever in a world without evil or pain.

The other point I would like to make is also extremely important. No one knows when the present age will end-a day from now or a thousand years from now. But are you ready? Have you accepted Christ as your Lord and Savior, and are you seeking to live for him? You can trust him right now and know that whatever happens, you are safe because you are Christ's.


