**LOCAL PLAYERS INJURED**

Playing a defensive game throughout the entire contest, the local high school gridders were defeated Wednesday afternoon by the strong Greensboro eleven by the overwhelming score of 38-0.

Although outclassed from the very first, the local team never stopped fighting. Time and again one player and then another suffered painful injuries, but they would not leave the game. They were fighting for the school they loved and although playing against great odds their spirit was never daunted. They remembered the H. P. H. S. slogan, "High Point never quits," and lived up to it until the very last minute of play.

The blue and white team held the "purple hurricane" to a scoreless tie in the first quarter, but in the second period a different story was told. A one after another of the local players were injured, the Gate City lads began to play a better game. By a series of brilliantly executed line buck forward passes, and fake end-runs they carried the pigskin across the goal for two touchdowns.

In the second half, with nearly all of the local players suffering with injuries, Greensboro scored almost a will. They uncorked an aerial attack which completely bewildered the crippled High Point team.

Just before the game ended Warner made a 25-yard run around right end but the ball was called back and the locals were penalized 10 yards.

C. Fuqua played a great defensive game until his leg was injured in the second period. Time and again he brought his man down with a brilliant tackle. Warner played a good game at halfback. His finger was dislocated in the second quarter, but after having it bandaged, he went back and finished the game. Dallas played a good game at center, although he was suffering with a sprained ankle.
