#### Program to Help All Handicapped Youth

North Carolina has again joined nationwide program to secure better educational facilities for handicapped and exceptional children. This summer more than 100 teachers, supervisors, and principals, were enrolled in North Carolina institutions of higher earning in courses designed help them in their regular class cooms, or in special classes for nandicapped children within the knowledge, they will go back to their schoolrooms this fall with a better understanding of the child who must cope with special andicaps along with their schoolwork. More than half of these professional people took course in speech pathology and speech correction. Other areas of study were the Exceptional Child: Mentally Retarded Child; Methods of Teaching Handicapped Children: plus regular courses in mental health, child psychology, etc.

Much of this training was made possible through scholarships of-fered to teachers by the North Carolina League for Crippled Children, your "Easter Seal Agency," whose special interest was in the field of special education. Scholarships totaling \$740.00 were awarded to seven of these professional people.

Dr. Clyde Erwin, State Superintendent of Education, has estimated that there are 85,000 handicapped or exceptional children of school age in North Carolina, and has also pointed out that during this past school year there were only nineteen specially trained teachers placed in the public schools throughout the state through the Special Education Division. Teachers are being added to this number just as fast as they are sufficiently trained and money is appropriated by the Legislature for this purpose.
