

"And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast. The same came therefore to Philip which was Beth saida of Galillee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus. (John 12:20, 21)

One day at the Feast of Pass over in Jerusalem a group of Gentiles came to Philip and desired to see Jesus. Therefore, the things I write about today will be some of the characteristics of the One Whom they sought.
