

Many of the plants that may be gathered now to dry are straw flowers, cockcomb, bells of Ireland, artemisia and money plant. These may be dried by hanging up side down in an attic or closet.

Grow Christmas peppers now for Christmas gifts. Apply dolomatic imestone for toad stools, puff balls and fairy rings in the lawn. Apply acti-dione, zinc or moneb for rust. To prevent nematodes, use Nemagon or Nemakril.

To pep up plants use Gremlin, vitamins for plant life. For tuberoses to bloom, plant deeper than two inches. Plant pansy seed, they make nicer blooms than the others. Steele pansies are a favorite.
