Quicker You Fix It The Sweeter Your Sweet Corn Stays

"Keep it cool." That is the Golden Rule for keeping sweet corn. As soon as sweet corn is picked, the sugars begin to turn to starch. At summer temperatures, sweet corn may lose as much as one-half its sweetness in 12 to 14 hours.

Mrs. Ruby P. Uzzle, consumer marketing specialist for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service, says that the quicker you use the corn, the sweeter it will be.

When you select ears of sweet corn, be guided by the husks and kernels. The husks should be green

and fresh-looking. The kernels should be plump and preferably at the "milk stage." If you press a kernel with the thumb-nail, a milky juice appears. Yellow varieties should have kernels that are not too deep a yellow.

You may find corn packed in film bags, without husks. Tests have shown that corn keeps well in film bags if it is kept at a low temperature.

For home canning, one bushel or five dozen ears of corn will yield about 17 pints of the frozen or canned product. One ear of corn about one-half cup when out from the cob.

Also remember that short cooking is another tip toward serving tender sweet corn. Do not overcook. Cook corn in boiling water only until done — about six to eight minutes.

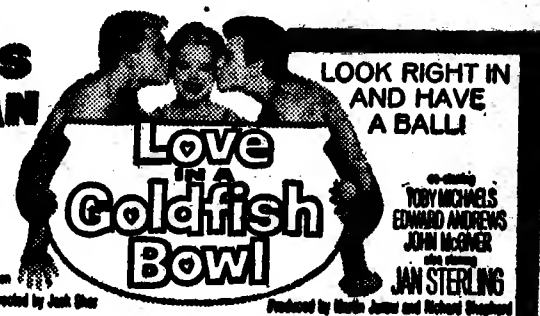
